REPORT ANTI CRACKER CAMPAIGN

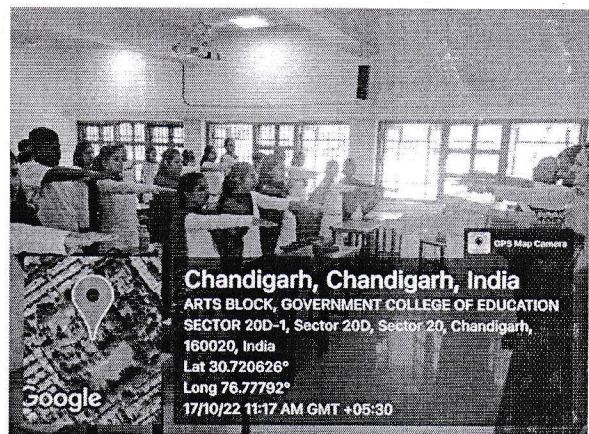


(17-20 Oct, 2022)

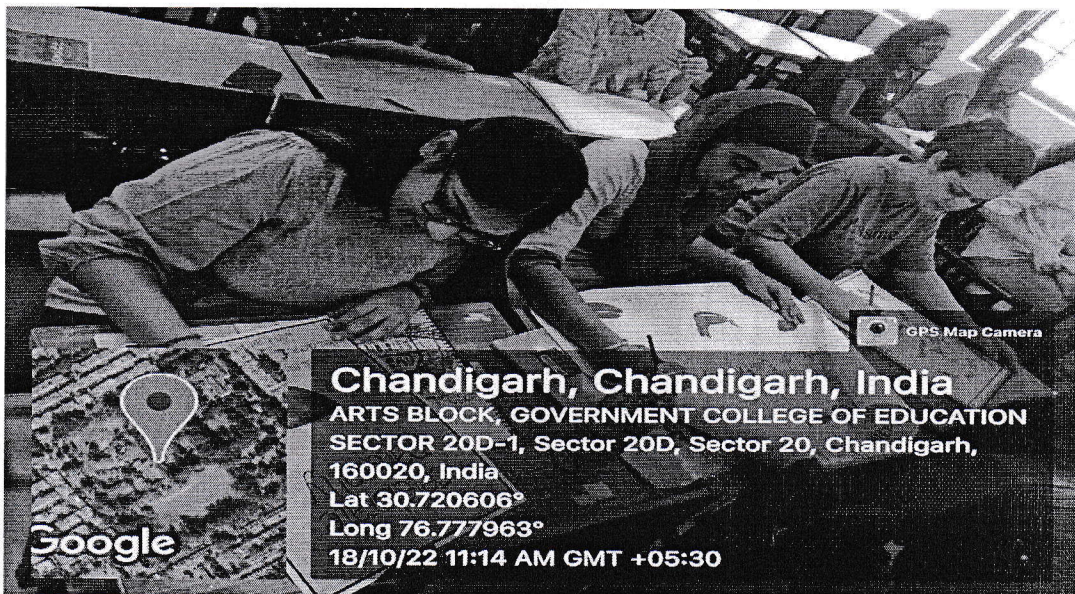

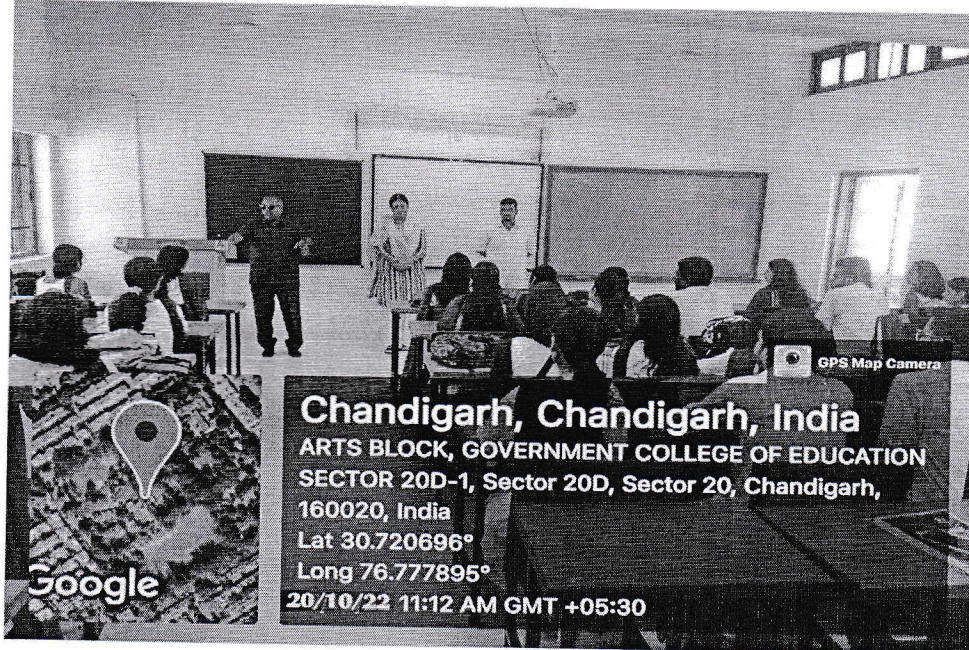
