Action Taken Report

In continuation to the previous meeting of Curriculum Enrichment Committee held on 19.07.2023, the following actions were taken:

- Dates for conducting first counselling for M.Ed., P.G.D.G &C and B.Ed. were decided. First Counselling for M.Ed & PGDG &C was held on 4th August 2023. B.Ed First Counselling will be held from 10th to 12th August 2023.
- The classes for M.Ed semester III have already started as per the time table. Furthermore time table for other classes of M.Ed. Sem I, P.G.D.G &C Sem I and B.Ed. Sem I has been framed and shall be implemented after the first counselling. Orientation Programme will be organised on 17th and 18th August 2023 and regular classes will commence from 21st August, 2023.
- As per the Panjab University academic calendar, B.Ed semester III School Internship programme Phase I commenced from 24th July 2023. A workshop on Effective use of Audio Visual Aids for classroom teaching was organised in the college on 28th July 2023. Demonstration and discussion lesson for all pedagogy subject were held from 31st July and 1st to 5th August 2023. Furthermore the students have reported in different school of Chandigarh according their respective Tutorial Group for teaching practice in school internship programme.
- For the college Academic calendar, different committees have submitted the schedule of planned activities for the academic session 2023-24 to Dr. Mukhtiar Singh Incharge College Calendar. Academic Calendar for ongoing Semester i.e from July 2023 to December 2023 is being drafted and the process shall be completed at the earliest.

- Considering the heavy rainfall in the month of July, the students coming from outstation facing transportation problems have been given relaxation for some time keeping in view of individual circumstances.
- As requested by student representatives, regarding frequently organised co-curricular activities during the session, a balance between academics and co-curricular activities shall be ensured.
- As per the discussion in the meeting, other academic and administrative issues are being taken up on priority basis for the welfare of students and smooth conduct of NAAC related work.
