Government College of Education, previously known as Government Post-Graduate Basic Training College, was founded in August 1954 under a special scheme of Government of India for establishment of training colleges for teachers at the post-graduate level. The National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) had accredited Grade 'A' to this College. The National Council for Teacher Education has sanctioned two unit of B.Ed. The college also runs 6 months Pre Ph.D. course work for research students in Education.
