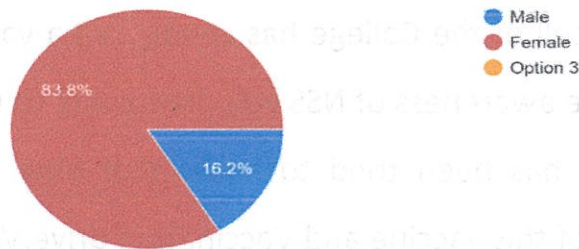
The survey related Google form has multiple choice questions about the vaccine and its related information. All NSS volunteers were advised to fill out this survey form on. Seven questions were asked in the survey and all the questions were set according to the guidelines of the Ministry of Family and Health Welfare, Government of India. Main theme of the survey was Covid-19 Vaccination awareness survey (Vaccine Drive). Seven questions are as given below;

1. Is vaccination mandatory for all?
2. Is registration is mandatory for the vaccination?
3. Does one need to wear mask or take precautions after getting vaccinated?
4. Is one dose of vaccine is sufficient to prevent covid-19?
5. Are there any side-effects of the Vaccine?
6. Has any member of your family been vaccinated recently?
7. Do you wish to associate yourself for creating awareness in the society?

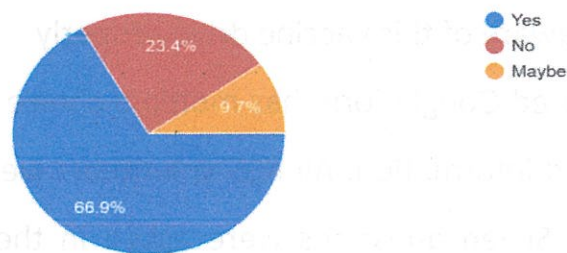

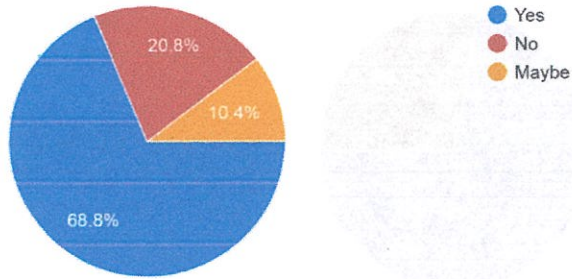

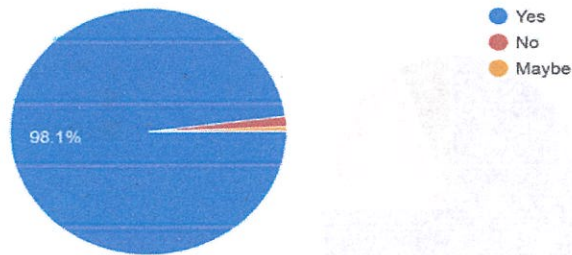

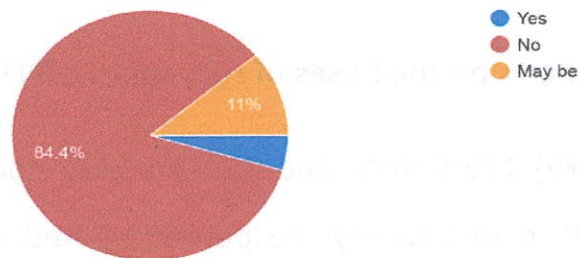

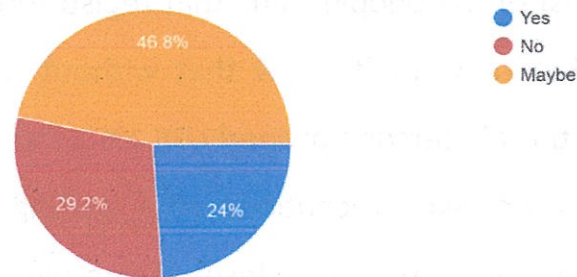

Are there any side-effects of the Vaccine?

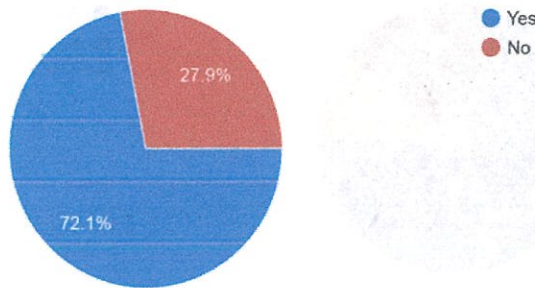

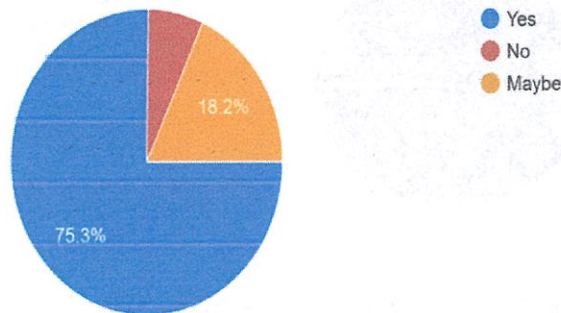
Has any member of your family been vaccinated recently?

### Data diagram charts on the bases of responses of NSS volunteers

Total 154 (145+9) 129 female and 25 male NSS volunteers and faculty members participated in this survey. Responses related with first question, vaccination mandatory for all is not much satisfactory. Vaccination is the most important for all in present circumstances. Only 69.9% people proposed vaccination for all. Most of the people think that registration is not mandatory for the vaccination. But they don't know that without registration it is not possible to vaccinate the all persons properly. 98.1% survey participants were in favor to wear mask or take precautions after getting vaccine dose also. Similarly 84.4% people think that one dose of vaccine is not sufficient to prevent covid-19.

We know that everyone wants to protect themselves. That is why he wants to make sure that it is not harmful for him before taking anything. This question related to the vaccine of Covid-19 is also in everyone's mind. 24% survey participants said that there are side-effects of the Vaccine 29.2 % responded no and 48.8 told that they are not aware about this. One thing of this survey is positive that 72.1% family members have vaccination experience. 75.3% people want to connect themselves to create awareness in the society.

This survey shows that what is going on in people's minds about the vaccine related to Covid-19. Everyone is only paying attention to whether to get the vaccine or not. They have doubt about the side effects of this vaccine? This is why we are not getting the full support of the people for the vaccine drive. All of us together should participate in the vaccination campaign in a big way. 75.3% NSS volunteers and teachers have given their consent to create awareness of vaccination campaign in the society. The survey was conducted to create awareness about the vaccination campaign among NSS volunteers, their family members and teachers. NSS Cell cannot claim any final result based on the facts of this survey.
