SOP for re-opening of the Hostel/Mess issued by Director Higher Education order no. 410-DHE-UT-C2-12()2021 Dated 20.02.2021, UGC guidelines dated 05.11.2020 & MHA order dated 27.01.2021 and further decided by this college committee keeping in view of the safety and health of the students and staff given below:-

- All Rooms will be sanitized regularly.
- Preference will be given to our college Final Year students while allotting rooms
 of hostels. However students from other colleges will also be accommodated as
 per previous practice
- All students are directed to submit COVID-19 recent negative test report not older than 3 days prior to joining by any Govt./ ICMR authorized lab and medical fitness certificate before applying for the hostels.
- Written consent of Parents/Guardian is mandatory before applying for the hostel.
- 5. Allowed Strength of Hostels:

Boys Höstel:

20 Students (2 students per room in 10 rooms)

Girls Hostel:

28 Students (2 students per room in 14 rooms)

- 6. All students are advised to install "Aarogya Setu App" in their mobile phones and students should also self-monitor their health.
- 7. Mess facility will be started only after attaining capacity of at-least 40 students total in both hostels, after that rate/meal charges will be decided by the committee.
- 8. Symptomatic students will not be permitted to stay in the hostel under any circumstances, if any student found symptomatic, he/she will be referred to the nearest facility for clinical assessment and treatment, and however allotted room to such student will be sanitized immediately.

- 9. There should be no crowding in hostel areas where students live in close proximity and share common facilities and utilities, students must maintain minimum distance of 6 feet (2 gaz ki doori) in college premises . Hence, their numbers need to be limited appropriately to avoid crowding.
- 10. Thermal screening of all resident students should be ensured, No outsider will be allowed to enter in the hostel premises in any circumstance without prior notice to warden/competent authority.
- 11. COVID test is Mandatory for the Mess contractor and their employees/workers.
- 12. Cleanliness to be maintained in dining areas. Meals should be served in small batches, avoiding over-crowding. Take away options should be available for students and staff.
- 13. Density in dining halls, common rooms, playing areas should be limited, keeping in the view the requirement of physical distancing.
- 14. Proper signage's, symbols, posters etc. should be prominently displayed at appropriate places to remind the students, faculty and staff for maintaining physical distancing.
- Spitting in campus premises will be punishable with fine.
- 16. UGC Guidelines for Re-opening of the institutions dated 05-11-2020 & MHA order dated 27-01- 2021 should be strictly followed by staff & students (Copies attached).
- 16. Wardens & Hostel Nurse shall take all necessary measure to promote COVID-19 appropriate behavior and ensure wearing of face mask, hand hygiene and social distancing.
- 17. Any person violating these measures will be liable to be proceeded against as per the provisions of Section 51 to 60 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, besides legal action under Section 188 of the IPC, and other legal provisions as applicable.
