





Government College of Education is dedicated to ethical and value enrichment of pupil teachers to enable them return the same to the society. We strive hard to prepare them for the challenges and opportunities of the future and become the nation builders. It is ensured that they remain connected to their roots in this modern and ever changing world as due emphasis is given on organization of activities which are based on Indian Knowledge system and interdisciplinary learning. The Annual Report of the current session is testament to these efforts.

#### **EXAMINATION RESULTS**

M.Ed., B.Ed. and Post Graduate Diploma in Guidance and Counselling courses of study were offered during the session 2021-2023.

In class M.Ed. 08 students appeared in M.Ed. (General) examinations held by Punjab University and all of them secured first division. Aarushi Sharma stood first by securing 81.35% marks followed by Neha Yadav with 81.30% marks. Anjali Kumari stood third who scored 80.75% marks.

106 students appeared in B.Ed. examinations out of which 103 were placed in first division. Ameesha Verma stood first by securing 87.25% whereas Ankita Ranout secured second position with 86.81% marks. Tanuja Upreti secured third position by securing 86.5% marks.

17 students appeared in PGDGC examinations for the session 2022-23. Rajeshwari Patel stood first by securing 77.50% whereas Bharti Sharma secured second position with 76.67% marks. Kritika Kapoor secured third position by securing 76.17% marks.

#### **ACHIEVEMENTS**

We take pride in the achievements and participations of our students in diverse arenas of activities. The following are the outcomes of various participations during the session 2023-24.

The cultural activities of the new session started with the 'Talent Hunt' which was conducted during Orientation Program on August 18th & 19th, 2023. Total 35 students presented diverse items viz. #### PLACEMENT CELL

The Placement Cell plays a proactive role in locating/responding to job opportunities in education and allied sectors for Under Graduate and Post Graduate students passing out from the college. It organizes various activities throughout the session in order to sharpen the professional skills of students and make them aware about different job opportunities. The cell works continuously to enhance employability skills of the students.

The Placement Cell operates round the year to facilitate contacts between college and professionals/experts from education sector and graduates. In the Academic session 2023-24, 12 students were placed as teachers in different school affiliated to CBSE/SBSE. A total of approximately 35 students cleared different competitive exams like UGC NET/SLET, CTET, HTET, HPTET etc. Furthermore, 45 students progressed into Higher education courses in different UGC recognized universities.

#### Following activities were undertaken in the academic session 2023-2024

- ➤ A 30 hours Value Added Course on Capacity Building on developing added skills towards Employability for Pupil Teachers from January 09, 2024 to January 13, 2024 with the focus area strategies to achieve SDGs on Food, Good Health and Wellbeing, Quality Education and Sustainable Environment under the guidance of Principal, Dr. Sapna Nanda, Patron VAC SDGs, Dr. Ravneet Chawla, Course Coordinator VAC SDGs and mentors Dr. Ravinder Kumar and Dr. Upasna Thapliyal. The beneficiaries of the programme were the students of B.Ed. semester IV, M.Ed. semester II and IV and PGDGC semester II. Continuous internal Evaluation (CIE) of student learning is one of the important components of the institution. College follows the guidelines issued by the Panjab University, Chandigarh regarding the approved process of conducting the continuous internal assessment of the students of the different courses run by the college i.e., M.Ed. (General), B.Ed. (General), and P.G. Diploma in Guidance and Counseling (PGDGC). The final internal assessment awards of the students are based on the performance of the candidate in term paper, house test, class assignments, attendance, and participation in discussions/seminars/tutorials, related practical and sessional work. The final list of internal assessment of all the papers of a semester is prepared by a panel of 3 senior teachers and the principal. Assessment for Engagement with the field(Pre-Internship) is based on the student's performance in various field related activities, practical, project work, community related work, diaries, student portfolios, field observations, visit to innovative pedagogy and learning centre, education resource centre etc

- 1. e-HRMS Manav Sampada: All the services applicable to Chandigarh Administration are implemented from time to time by the college. Data related to College employees such as Annual Property Return (APR), Annual Performance Appraisal Report (APAR) are maintained and employees can access all the services offered through e-HRMS portal
- 2. e-Sevarth: It is an important component of IFMS (Integrated Finance management system) with facility for data exchange with other modules of IFMS. Government employee of Chandigarh Administration including employees of this college can access their salary statement or slip and personal information from SEVAARTH portal of Finance Department of Chandigarh Administration.

# 3. Biometric Attendance for Employees and students

College has installed biometric systems to capture the attendance of all the employees to maintain the record of their physical presence in the institution. Biometric attendance system is also installed for the students of M. Ed., PGDGC and B.Ed. to capture their daily attendance and keep a track of regularity of the students in the college. Biometric attendance is compiled every month and record is maintained.

# 4. Library Management

The college is using INFLIBNET and Libsys software and strives to promote remote access facility to all the stakeholders. College has also installed RFID system in the library to facilitate easy access and issue return of the books to the faculty and students.

# **5.** Right to Service Act

With reference to the Govt. of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, vide Notification G.S.R. 1015(E), dated 14th August, 2017, the college has initiated a mechanism for hassle free, transparent and time-bound mechanism for students for procuring necessary documents which is updated on the college website on regular basis.

# **6.** E-Campus Management:

The whole college campus including Administrative Blocks, Boys Hostels, Girls Hostel, Mess Area, Lawns, Auditorium, Labs etc. is under 24 hours CCTV surveillance. Thus the whole campus is monitored and effectively managed.

**E-Governance in College Financial Management:** all the financial health components of the college are taken care of through following online services of Govt. of India/ Chandigarh Administration:

#### 1. PFMS

It is a complete suite of applications used by Govt. of India for Planning, Budgeting, Receipt and Expenditure control, Payment Processing, Debt Management and Audit. It is mandatory for the government departments in UT Chandigarh to record all the transactions through digital mode and College is compliant to the Payment related guidelines issued by Chandigarh Administration from time to time. College is using PFMS to maintain the financial health of the institution.

#### 2. Government e-Market Place (GeM)

All the procurement in the college is done through GeM and payments to the vendors are made through PFMS portal of Govt. of India.

# 3. College Fee/ Fine/Dues Digital Payments

College does not accept fees in cash; every type of payment to the college is made in digital mode only. Students are required to pay their fees/ fine online through e-Sampark portal. In addition to this every type of dues and funds of the college are maintained in the digital format through the central treasury of the Chandigarh Administration.

**E-Governance in Student Admission:** College simplified the admission to various courses run in the institutions through following means:

1. Online Admission through Department of Higher Education Chandigarh Administration Portal:

Admission to M.Ed. and PGDGC courses are done through online portal of the directorate of Higher Education, Chandigarh Administration every year.

2. Online B. Ed. admission through Panjab University Portal Admission to the B. Ed. (general) two year course of the colle

Admission to the B. Ed. (general) two year course of the college is through entrance test conducted by the Panjab University and all centralised admission process for all college of education situated in Chandigarh is carried out by the Panjab University through a dedicated portal. All relevant information including merit, admission, counselling etc is displayed on the portal. Students are provided with all the support needed by the college.

**E-Governance in Student Evaluation:** The College follow the guidelines of Panjab University regards to Examination and Evaluation in toto.

1. Panjab University Examination Portal for UG Courses:

The information related to examination such as application for examination, admit card, datasheet of examination, centre allotment, re-evaluation, results etc. for the M.Ed. and PGDGC courses can be accessed through Panjab University PG examination portal. This portal also caters to college for uploading of internal and external awards of the post graduate students.

2. Panjab University Examination Portal for PG Courses:

The information related to examination such as application for examination, admit card, datasheet of examination, centre allotment, re-evaluation, results etc. for the B.Ed. course can be accessed through Panjab University UG examination portal. This portal also caters to college for uploading of internal and external awards of the under graduate students.

Thus, the college followed the e-governance policy of the Chandigarh Administration and Panjab University during the session 2023-24 also to improve the service delivery to the stakeholders in the institution.

#### LECTURE SHORTAGE

All the students of M.Ed., B.Ed. and PGDG&C classes are expected to be regular in attending classes according to the time-table in force.

- ❖ They must attend at least 80 percentages in theory and practical's/ total lectures delivered in each subject and 90 percent in school internship.
- ❖ Information regarding students falling short of lectures is sent to their parents/ guardians invariably as per the practice of this college.

- ❖ Students can check their lecture shortage statements from Student Notice Board from time to time.
- ❖ Students can claim the benefit of Medical leave/ Special leave granted by the principal. They must note that the medical leave /special leave will just waive off their fine during leave period
- ❖ Attendance is compulsory in the entire academic, cultural and sports functions of the college.

#### **BIOMETRIC ATTENDANCE**

- ❖ Bio Metric Attendance System for Students for B.Ed., M.Ed. and PGDG&C has been installed and working as per the norms. Also, Students' attendance record is maintained as per the requirement of Panjab University regulations.
- ❖ The Bio Metric Attendance system of the staff and Bio Metric Machine is installed and working.
- ❖ Biometric attendance of Non-Teaching and contractual Staff of the college has already been implemented.

This distinguished cohort, comprising five illustrious faculty members and fifty-five enthusiastic students from the B.Ed program, set out on a transformative journey to the historic realms of Jodhpur and Jaisalmer, Rajasthan. This educational pilgrimage, a cornerstone of the B.Ed 4th semester curriculum, commenced its inaugural chapter on the evening of March 19th, 202 and ending on March 23, 2024 heralding the dawn of a narrative steeped in exploration and enlightenment.

#### **COLLEGE LIBRARY**

The College Library act as a Learning Resources Centre (LRC) to support the educational and research programs of the institute by providing intellectual access to information to the faculty and students for their teaching and research.

Knowing the immense significance of library, our college has been continuously trying to update the library by introducing new books and magazines. The library has 44304 books including Reference collection, Encyclopedias, Dictionaries, bound volumes of educational journals, Dissertations, Handbooks and Surveys etc.

During this session 363 books has been added through M&S plan in the library. The library subscribes 55 journals and newspapers. This year library upgraded to latest version LIBSYS 10 (Web Centric LMS) Software on cloud computing services and a web browser based user interface. It is a web based library management solution to enhance the total library experience through value added features and services.

Our college library is functioning on open access system to students and staff. The Library offers wide range of information services like reference, bibliographic, current awareness, orientation and reprographic services etc. Book Bank facility is also provided to needy students. Library has organized different competitions like book hunting, poster making, book mark making and book exhibition on special days or events to motivate students to use library resources in creative and learning manner.

Library is fully computerized with 13 computers. Students and staff can use these computers for research and learning purpose.

Our college library is fully computerized, working of all the sections of the library are computerized. Issue/Return of books to students, Barcodes, Spine labels, Catalogue cards and Library Membership card (SMART CARDS) are generated through Libsys software.

Library provides web OPAC services; through which students and staff can find all the collection of the library from anywhere or 24x7.

To get access to various e-books and e-journals library subscribes 'N-list programme of INFLIBNET' for college faculty and students for their research and learning purpose. Users can have access to more than 6,300+ electronic journal and 31, 3500+ electronic books from anywhere using their user name and password.

New Arrivals of books and journals are displayed on racks. The library has under closed circuit television (CCTV) surveillance Cameras. Library has implemented RFID (Radio-Frequency Identification) system for Faster transactions like issue return used in stock verification through automated tracking solution. Security of library items is done through RFID security gates. All RFID tags within range can be detected instantly and matched with information in the database.

Activities conducted in the year 2023-2024:

- Orientation programme was conducted for user information.
- Book exhibition or display of books on the occasion of Gandhi Jayanti.
- Book Marks making, Poster making and Book hunting competitions have been conducted to motivate students to use library resources in creative and learning manner.
