Minutes of IQAC meeting:

1. Environment Sustainability measures:

The meeting commenced with a discussion on environment sustainability and beautification measures to be implemented within the college premises. Various proposals were put forth by the committee members. These proposals included:

- Improvement of waste management measures including timely collection of waste materials.
- Marking on roads and trees alongside the road.
- Providing more facilities for vermicomposting.
- Plantation drives to increase green cover within the campus.
- Installation of more lights in the dark corners of the campus.

2. DVV and Peer Team Visit for NAAC accreditation:

The upcoming NAAC accreditation visit was discussed in detail. It was noted that preparation for the visit should be meticulous and comprehensive. The following action points were identified:

- Coordinating with all concerned to ensure compliance with accreditation process.
- As the college is already conducting extension activities through USOL programmes, it was suggested by Prof. Sunil Dutt to introduce the extension activities for School mentors of Internship Schools and clusters of Chandigarh region.

3. E-content Development:

The importance of developing high-quality e-content for enhancing the learning experience was emphasized. The following steps were proposed:

- Identifying subject matter experts to create e-content for various courses.
- Providing training to faculty members on e-content creation tools and techniques.
- Establishing an organized subject wise repository to store and disseminate econtent.

4. Development of MOOCs:

The potential of Massive Open Online Courses in supplementing traditional classroom teaching was discussed. The following strategies were proposed for developing MOOCs:

- Identifying key areas suitable for online delivery by syncing E-content with MOOCs.
- Integrating MOOCs into the curriculum to offer students blended learning and flip classroom experiences.
- Providing necessary support and resources to faculty members for creating MOOCs.

5. Learning Management Measures:

There was detailed discussion on measures to enhance learning management within the college. The following initiatives were proposed.

- Coordinating with Panjab university for implementing a centralized Learning Management System (LMS) for efficient academic management and communication.
- Conducting orientation with Department of Computer Science, PU on using the LMS effectively.

The IQAC meeting ended with a commitment to implement the discussed measures effectively to enhance the overall quality of education and ensure compliance with accreditation standards.
