- ➤ Become responsible and informed digital citizens.


Second Resource person of the session was Brahmakumari (BK) Sister Neha. She explained beautifully that in quest for balance and inner peace, we often turn to other external things.


The resource person emphasized that the practice of Om Shanti Om offers:


- A valuable way to cultivate inner peace and harmony through meditation and mantra recitation techniques.

- A powerful practice to achieve the state of inner peace.


