Orientation Programme for the newly admitted students of B. Ed.1st Semester, M. Ed. 1st Semester and PGDGC 1st Semester was organised in the College Auditorium. The orientation programme was inaugurated by the esteemed guest Retired Prof (Dr.) Y. K. Ananad of National Institute of Technical Teachers Training, Sector-26, Chandigarh. All the students and all the faculty members and support staff enthusiastically participated in the programme. 
